

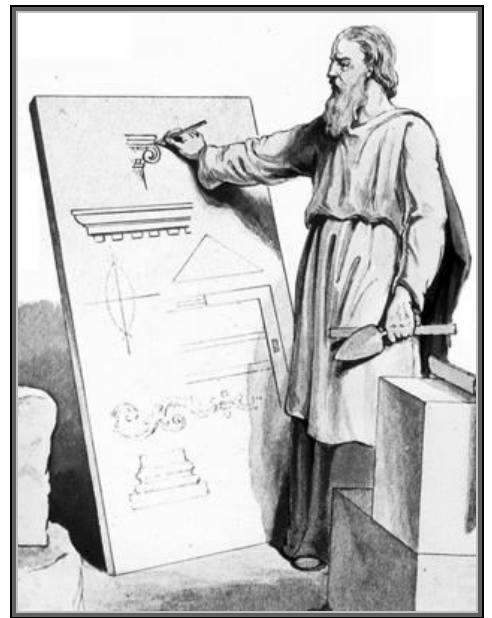

MASTER'S MESSAGE

Already the hot summer days are giving way to the cool dewy nights of fall. As Masons, we are taught to learn from the great Book of Nature, and when we do, we find that Nature is an hourglass that speaks more eloquently than any chronometer of the passage of time. Time is in fact a major theme throughout our ritual.

This is evident from the moment we knocked on the door of the Lodge room. As we stood there, eager to begin the first step of a journey we undertook so earnestly and deliberately, the first thing we were instructed to do was to wait a time with patience. Later on in our journey we learned that time is precious and that we should make industrious use of it, seizing our opportunities without delay, lest we look back someday to find months or years squandered. Time is our adversary, laying waste and destroying the great monuments of our labor. Time is also our friend, with whom all things can be accomplished when accompanied by patience and perseverance. Time is something we understand through the application of Geometry and the study of astronomy.

As Masons, how are we to regard time? The answer, I think, lies in the numerous uses in ritual of the phrase "in due time," which signifies that all things happen when they are appropriate, whether we know it or not. Many of us find this concept difficult to understand, being human as we are. Another way to look at it, however, is through the symbol of the compass. Masons use it to draw the circle, which teaches us self-control, but is also emblematic of timeless eternity.

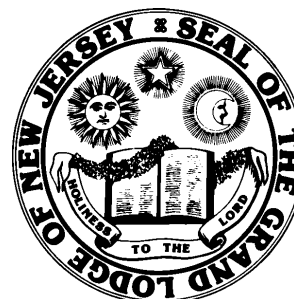

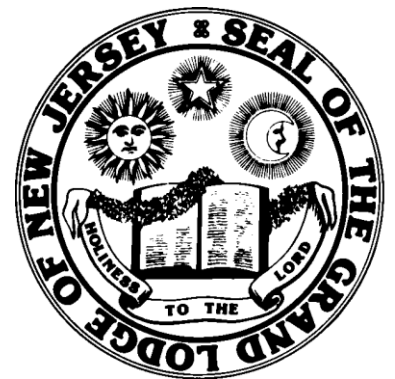

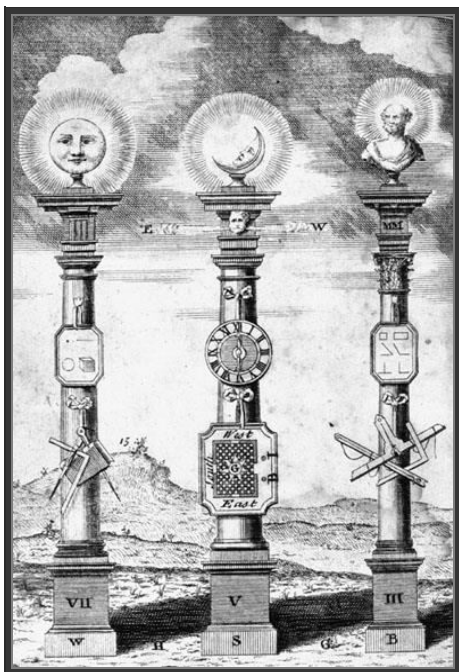
